coordinator and Dr Jonathan Michael at the Queen Elizabeth Hospital Birmingham.





Len was always fully involved with the K.P.A. in fund raising and supporting the Hospital. Many long days were spent in the cold collecting and running tombola's etc.in supermarket entrances in winter. He Informed the public at World Kidney Days making them aware of the work of the Hospital's Renal Department and that of the Queen Elizabeth Hospital Kidney Patients Association.

In the early days of the K.P.A. they had an old red London Bus which was taken round to do street collections and also to take patients on outings to

Weston and other seaside destinations. On one occasion it was take to Belgium with a party of renal patients.
