A few months ago, while in CAPD reception I got involved in a talk around APD set up and it was brought to my attention that I could use the Sani-Cloths to clean the new HomeChioce APD machine as well as work surface areas. Much better than wet paper towels and Carex. Of course, this is the outside of the machine only. To clean the cassette draw you simply wipe occasionally with a dry paper towel.
